✓ \_\_\_\_\_ is a form of love.

**Hebrews 12:6 (CEV)** The Lord corrects the people he loves and disciplines those he calls his own.

**Romans 15:14 (NKJV)** Now I myself am confident concerning you, my brethren, that you also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

**Noutheteo** {*noo-thet-eh'-o*} to place on one's mind (by implication) to caution, to reprove or rebuke gently, to correct or warn

**Colossians 1:28** He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.

**Proverbs 27:6** Wounds from a friend can be trusted, but an enemy multiplies kisses.
