

Do What Jesus Did

- ✓ Faith isn't proven by what we say about Jesus but by how we live like Jesus.

John 14:12 (NLT) "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me **will do** the **same works** I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

Luke 6:40 (NLT) Students are not greater than their teacher. But the student who is **fully trained** will become like the teacher.

1. Jesus Proclaims Good News

- ✓ Disciples don't just consume the Gospel; they carry it everywhere in conversations, in workplaces, in their neighborhoods.

Matthew 9:35 (NLT) Jesus traveled through all the towns and villages of that area, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom. And he healed every kind of disease and illness.

2. Jesus Heals The Broken

- ✓ Disciples bring God's healing into hurting lives sometimes through prayer, sometimes through presence, always through compassion.

Mark 1:41 (NLT) Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!"

3. Jesus Embraces Outsiders

- ✓ Disciples make room for people others push out welcoming the overlooked, befriending the broken, and opening the table for all.

Luke 5:31-32 (NLT) Jesus answered them, "Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do. ³² I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners and need to repent."

4. Jesus Serves With Humility

- ✓ Disciples pick up the towel, not the throne. True greatness is found in serving others the way Jesus did.

John 13:14-15 (NLT) And since I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other's feet. ¹⁵ I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.
